Where will our Monument be?

Carved in Georgian granite, our monument will occupy pride of place on a pathway with other distinguished infantry units on the 'Walk of Honor' at the National Infantry Center and Museum at Fort Benning, Georgia.

Why Fort Benning?

Not only have we all trained there but the 23rd's famed World War I regimental commander, Colonel Paul Malone, DSC, was seminal in 'standing up' the School of Infantry in the 1920s. He designed the distinctive FOLLOW ME insignia and badge. The Infantry Museum and the Walk of Honor have become one of Georgia's most popular attractions for visitors and veterans alike.

How much will we need to raise?


The Great Regimental Run of 2013. All three battalions together at JBLM at one time!
